<b>Morphine</b>	MST Continus®	<p>Requires safe custody in a Controlled Drug (CD) cupboard.</p> <p>Must be recorded in the CD register.</p> <p>2 trained members of staff need to sign for administration in the CD register.</p> <p>Balance checks must be completed weekly.</p>

<b>Buprenorphine</b>	Butec®	<p>Buprenorphine and temazepam must be stored in the CD cupboard.</p> <p>Other CDs listed in schedule 3 do not need to be stored in the CD cupboard.</p> <p>It is good practice to make a record of the usage of schedule 3 CDs in the CD record book.</p>
