

Supplementary Statement to Powys Teaching Health Board Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment

This supplementary statement is issued under regulation 6 of the NHS (Pharmaceutical Services) (Wales) Regulations 2020.

Date supplementary statement issued – 24 September 2025

The following pharmacy has notified the health board of their intention to withdraw from the NHS Pharmaceutical Services Contract with effect from 31st December 2025:

- Danby's Pharmacy, 27 High Street, Llanfyllin, SY22 5AA

In addition to essential pharmaceutical services, the pharmacy currently provides the following:

- Clinical Community Pharmacy Service
 - Common Ailments Service
 - Contraception Services
 - Emergency Medicines Supply
- Smoking cessation Level 2 – supply of pharmacotherapy
- Patient sharps service
- Supervised Administration of Medicines
- Lateral Flow Test Supply Service

These services are currently provided at the following times:

The pharmacy will close on 31st December 2025.

The Local Health Board considers that this closure will create a gap in pharmaceutical services, which could be addressed by establishing a new pharmacy in the Llanfyllin area providing essential services, the Clinical Community Pharmacy Service, and additional clinical services for a minimum of 40 contracted core hours per week.

It would be expected that the opening hours of any new pharmacy would broadly reflect those currently offered in order to maintain continuity of access for patients.
