Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 19 April 2023, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) partly holds the information that you require.

For ease of reference your request is set out below and our response follows:

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would like to request the following information regarding adult neurological and mental health services. Please provide answers on the attached and accompanying Excel spreadsheet.

For the avoidance of doubt, when referring to the terms 'neurological' and 'neurological disorders', please include brain injury (including acquired brain injury and traumatic brain injury), spinal injury, neuro-disabilities (including but not limited to Parkinson's disease, early-onset dementia, multiple sclerosis, motor neurone disease, Huntington's disease, cerebral palsy and epilepsy), stroke, neurobehavioural rehabilitation and cognitive rehabilitation. Please note the following: Financial information includes all Mental Health and Learning Disability packages, including joint packages with Local Authorities (LA), hosted by Health. The weekly rate reflects the rate paid by the Health Board, not the full weekly package cost. Packages hosted by LA have been

excluded, we are unable to identify settings required as per the FOI. PTHB are unable to identify the age group from the report, the packages 18 years plus.

Q3 I can confirm that PTHB is not able to supply the data for the following financial years 2019 /20, 2020.21 and 2022/23. In order to answer your question this would require a manual trawl of all patients' medical records. We estimate that the cost of complying with your request would exceed the fees limit of £450 set by the Freedom of Information Act. We estimate that one person would need to spend 3½ working days to determine whether the Health Board holds the information, and locating, retrieving and extracting the information. Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act the Health Board is therefore not obliged to comply with this part of your request.

Q7 – 10 Please note that we do not hold information separately for Neurodevelopment so are unable to answer these questions. The financial data is not yet available for financial year 2023/24.
