Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Please could you provide information on the following:

1. Total amount of funding provided from your Health Board given to Local & National Charities.
2. List of Charities that have benefited from Health Board funding.

Please provide the information for each of the three financial years separately and list all grants/funding separately.

Clarification Requested:

Regarding question 1, Please can you clarify what is meant by 'funding provided from your Health Board given to Local & National Charities',

For example, the Health Board currently has expenditure with Local and National Charities for a variety of items such as the delivery of healthcare related services, provision of training courses and hire of facilities.
Or is the reference to 'given' as meaning monies provided to a charity with no requirements in return or stipulations on what it is to be used for.

Clarification Received:

I am seeking information regarding any funding given to Local or National Charities either as a donation or to provide services. e.g. to charities such as MIND, 2wish, Reablement support etc.
