Please note:

- PTHB does not have some of the specialities listed in your initial request.
- Where fields are marked \*, PTHB are unable to provide the data as originally requested due to the low numbers (less than 5) of individuals involved. PTHB believes there is a potential risk of individuals being able to be identified, when considered with other information already available within the public domain, if this was disclosed. Therefore, the data is classed as personal data as defined under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 and its

However, under Section 16 of the FOIA under the duty of a public authority to provide advice and assistance, we have provided data on the age, gender, ethnicity and disability, but not in the requested breakdown.
