Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 18 March 2024, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require.

For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows each question individually.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I would be most grateful if you would provide me, under the Freedom of Information Act, details with respect to the Trust below, details of which can be found below:

1. Approximately how many endoscopes does the trust own?

Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) currently owns 53 endoscopes.

2. What brands of endoscope does the Trust own?

The brands of endoscopes owned by PTHB are Pentax and Olympus.

3. On average how old are the endoscopes that the Trust owns?

The average age of PTHB owned endoscopes is six years.

4. Approximately how many of the trust endoscopes are under OEM Warranty?

The number of endoscopes under OEM warranty is 46.

The value of the contract when awarded was £157,855.06.

The contract type provides fully comprehensive cover.

The contract renewal date is 30th November 2024.

The contract includes the provision of loan equipment if required.

Managed Equipment Service


An MES seeks to provide a more holistic solution to a department, typically encompassing equipment recommendations, supply, replacement and disposal – occasionally providing staff also.
