I write further to your request for information, which was received on 20 March 2024, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) partly holds the information that you require.

Powys Response:

1a & 1b. I can confirm Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) Community Consultant Paediatricians provide a diagnostic service based on the Scottish Intercollegiate Guidelines Network Guide (SIGN 156 (2019)) and National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) quality standard 204. Management following diagnosis will be provided by Community Paediatric or Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS). Other support is provided through schools and self-help groups. Some adopted children may receive specialist services commissioned by the local authority.


