DAFNE - contract expires September 2025. No agreed contract end for XPERT/XPERT Insulin, but dietitians need to review their licences every 2 years.

6. When you seek to award a new contract for any of the above services, would you consider the existing provider to be the only capable provider? If yes, please detail why.

Our pathways/ providers would be determined by All Wales Adult DM Lead Dietitian.

7. Considering the new PSR transparency and record keeping, please can you confirm what Key Performance Indicators you will be assessing service provision against, and please advise whether the current incumbent providers are meeting these KPIs in full. These criteria usually include quality, innovation, value, integration, collaboration, service sustainability, improvement of access, reduction of health inequalities, facilitating choice and social value.

XPERT KPIs include biochemical & anthropometric outcomes, and patient attendance and experience, and overall positive results are recorded. DAFNE has similar KPIs but more focussed on DM control linked to medication. DAS measures patient experience.


