Powys Response:

Q1. I can confirm the Powys Living Well Service provides support for Long Covid for Adults in Powys.

Q2 & Q4. There is no specialist Long Covid clinic for Children. However, individuals aged 16-18 may be referred to the adult service as above.

Q3. Not Applicable.

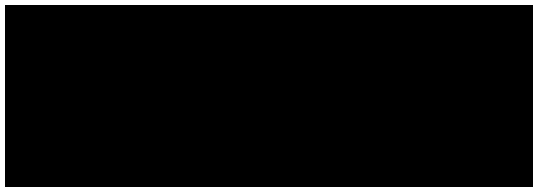
Q5. No clinics or services have closed down during the current calendar year.
