## Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 01 April 2025 to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

### Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I would like to request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000:

Q1. Can you please let me know the number of senior project managers, project managers, senior project support officers, project officers, project support assistants employed?

Q2. Could you also let me know the total cost of employing these roles?

Q3. Could you let me know the number of Equality, Diversity and Inclusion roles, and the associated costs please?

### Powys Response:

Q1. I can confirm that there are 17.14 Full Time Equivalent posts. These roles include:

- Project Management,
- Project officers and
- Senior Project Support Officers.

Q2. I can confirm the total cost for employing these roles is £945,778.

Q3. I can confirm that there are 0.83 Full Time Equivalent posts. These posts consist of:

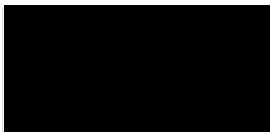

The only associated cost with these roles is the annual salary, both roles are undertaken by one member of staff. We are therefore withholding this detail under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 as the data is classed as personal data as defined under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 and its disclosure would be contrary to the data protection principles and constitute unfair and unlawful processing in regard to Articles 5, 6, and 9 of UK GDPR. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.

Under the terms of the Health Board's Freedom of Information procedure, individuals seeking access to recorded information held by the Health Board are entitled to request an internal review of the handling of their requests.
