Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 09 April 2025 and subsequent clarification received on 16 April 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I am writing to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I am requesting the following information:

Q1. The percentage of people who were offered a covid vaccine booster, who then had it administered over the last three years.

Q2. The percentage of adults who were offered a flu vaccine, who then had it administered over the last three years.

Q3. The percentage of children who were given the 6-in-1 vaccine, the Rotavirus vaccine the MenB vaccine.

Q4. The percentage of children who were given the 6-in-1 vaccine (2nd dose), Pneumococcal vaccine, Rotavirus vaccine (2nd dose).

Q5. The percentage of children who were given the 6-in-1 vaccine (3rd dose), MenB vaccine (2nd dose).

Q6. The percentage of children given the Hib/MenC vaccine (1st dose), MMR vaccine (1st dose), Pneumococcal vaccine (2nd dose), MenB vaccine (3rd dose).

Q7. The percentage of children who were given the MMR vaccine (2nd dose) and the 4-in-1 pre-school booster vaccine.

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Q8. The percentage of children given the HPV vaccine.

Q9. The percentage of children given the Td/IPV vaccine (3-in-1 teenage booster) and the MenACWY vaccine.

Q10. The percentage of children who were given a flu booster broken down by age group.

Clarification Requested:

Q3- Q10. Please clarify the time period that you are requesting this data for.

Q3- Q10. Please can you confirm the age range.

Q3 – Q7 & Q9. Please can you also confirm if you would like the information in these subgroups or as a whole.

Clarification received:

The age range will be for everyone under the age of 16. The time frame would be for the last five years or if that is not possible the last three and yes could this be broken down in subgroups, broken down by each request please.

Powys Response:

Q1 – Q10. Under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act, an organisation does not have to respond to a request if the information being sought is reasonably accessible to the applicant by another means. Section 21 is absolute and therefore does not require a public interest test. Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) has applied this exemption to your request as the information you are seeking is available in the public domain.
