## Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 15 April 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

### Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Q1. I'm interested to know how many Cardiopulmonary Exercise Testing Systems (CPET/CPEX) are in use throughout the trust. For each system I'd like to know:

- a. The number of current devices in use.
- b. Manufacturer and type of device.
- c. Which hospitals are they in.
- d. Which departments are they in.
- e. Date of installation.

### Powys Response:

Q1a – Q1e. I can confirm we do not use any Cardiopulmonary Exercise Testing Systems within Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB). Therefore this is a nil response.
