Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 23 April 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require but have applied an exemption to elements of this request. For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Q1. Requesting a FOI for the annual Duty of Candour report for the years 2023-24 and 2024-25. I could not find them on your public website.

With regards to 2024/25 – This information is intended for future publication in September 2025; therefore Section 22 of the Freedom of Information Act has been applied – Information intended for future publication. Section 22 is a qualified class-based exemption and consideration must be given as to whether there is a public interest in providing the information prior to the anticipated publication.

Information is exempt if, at the time when the public authority receives a request for the information:

- The public authority holds the requested information.
- The public authority intends the information to be published at some future date, whether that date is determined or not; and
- In all the circumstances it is reasonable to withhold the information under its planned publication.

Considerations favouring non-disclosure:

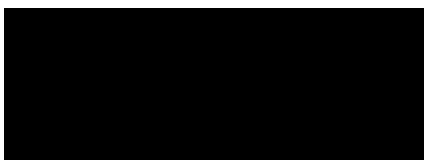
PTHB is committed to publishing information, however we do not consider that it is in the public interest to place information into the public domain, prematurely, before pre-publication procedures have taken place.
