I can confirm that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not have Accident and Emergency (A&E) departments, only Minor Injury Units (MIU). PTHB's MIU's do not have the ability to test or treat for carbon monoxide poisoning. Powys

based patients would be taken to A&E at a neighbouring Health Board, I therefore recommend that you approach them for this information directly:
