Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 27 August 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require, but have applied an exemption to elements of this request. For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request and Powys Response (Bold):

For your organisation's mental health services, please provide the current post-holder details (as at today's date) for the following roles (or closest local equivalent):

The Health Board is withholding names and contact details of members of staff whose job may fit some of these titles. This decision has been made as it is not within the expectations of the individual that their personal data would be put into the public domain. This information is classed as personal data of third parties and is therefore being withheld in accordance with section 40 (2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) by virtue of section 40 (3) (a) (i) of the Act which permits a public authority to withhold personal data other than the requester's where the disclosure would breach a Data Protection Principle.

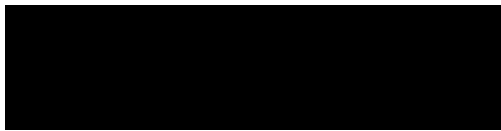
