Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 23 December 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) partly holds the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and the Health Board's response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I would be very grateful if you could provide, under the Freedom of Information Act, the following details:

Q1. Please can you advise if you commission dementia support services?

Q2. If you do commission dementia support services, please can you confirm:

- a) who is the current provider?
- b) what are the current contract start and end dates?
- c) what is the annual contract value?
- d) are you planning to retender when the current contract comes to an end?

Powys Response:

Q1. I can confirm that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not directly commission dementia support services.

Any commissioning for Dementia Services are part of Regional Partnership Board (RPB) considerations given ringfenced funding to deliver the Dementia Action Plan for Wales is allocated directly to the RPB for implementation and to develop a joint health and social care approach to dementia support.

RPBs were established as part of the Social Services and Well Being Act and bring together health boards, local authorities and the third sector to meet the care and support needs of people in their area to:

- improve the well-being of the population
- improve how health and care services are delivered

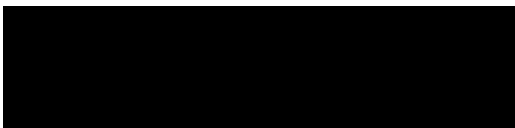
Re-use of Public Sector Information
