Request under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 28 February 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) partly holds the information that you require.

For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I am currently completing a master's degree in business management and writing a dissertation on decarbonisation within the NHS. As part of my research, I am keen to review the full plan and emissions information outlined in your organisation's Climate Action Plan. Would it please be possible to provide me with a copy of the full plan and any related emissions data?

Powys Response:

Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not have a published Climate Action Plan. The Health Board's response to the Climate Emergency is aligned with Welsh Government's Decarbonisation Strategic Delivery Plan to help NHS Wales contribute towards making the Welsh public sector net zero by 2030.
