## Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 10 January 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

### Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I should like to request the following information about medical staffing.

1. How many doctors were employed by your Health Board in the years 2023 and 2024? Please provide these numbers divided by type of doctor (I.e. Trainee, Consultant, Locally employed - LED, Specialty associate specialist specialty-SAS, GP). Please also provide for each type and year both a Headcount and a Whole-time-equivalent.

2. What is the estimated population served by your Health Board, based on the 2021 census or current ONS estimates? Please provide the raw population total and the NHS weighted total.

It would be most helpful to have this information in the form of a spreadsheet, please, NOT a pdf document.
