Powys Response:

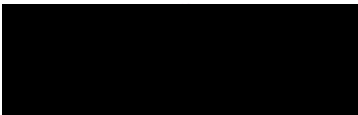
Q1. Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not have any Accident and Emergency Departments only Minor Injury Units (MIU). Our response is therefore based on our MIUs. I can confirm there are 21 Nurses in PTHB MIU's. I can confirm there are no Doctors or Physician Associates (PA's).

Q2 & Q3. I can confirm all nurses wear navy. As per our response to question 1, PTHB does not have Doctors or PA's in MIU.
