Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 15 January 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require.

For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I would like to make an application under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 for the following information: (please provide the figures from January 2022 - present, in calendar years not fiscal).

1. How many children (persons under the age of 18) have been prescribed with adrenaline auto-injectors (AAI) since 2022? Please provide a breakdown of the data per year.
2. How many adults (persons aged 18 and over) have been prescribed with adrenaline auto-injectors (AAI) since 2022? Please provide a breakdown of the data per year.

Powys Response:

Q1 & Q2. I can confirm Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information on the number of adrenaline auto-injectors which have been dispensed for both adult and children. This data is held with the General Practitioners (GP). For GP data you will need to contact the GP Practices directly for this information.
