Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 28 July 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) partly holds the information that you require, but have applied an exemption to elements of this request.

For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows each question individually.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request and Powys Response (Bold):

I am writing to request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act:

Q1. The name and email address of your Clinical Safety Officer.

I can confirm that PTHB does not have a dedicated Clinical Safety Officer (CSO). While the DCB0129 and DCB0160 Clinical Safety Standards developed by NHS England provide a structured approach to clinical risk management in digital systems, these standards are not currently mandated in NHS Wales. As such, there is no formal requirement for Health Boards in Wales to appoint a CSO at this time.

Q2. The name and email address of your Chief Pharmacist.

I can confirm that the email address for the Chief Pharmacist is Powys.MMPA@wales.nhs.uk

The Health Board is withholding the name of the member of staff whose job may fit this title. This decision has been made as it is not within the expectations of the individual that their personal data would be put into the public domain. This information is classed as personal data of third parties and is therefore being withheld in accordance with section 40 (2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) by virtue of section

40 (3) (a) (i) of the Act which permits a public authority to withhold personal data other than the requester's where the disclosure would breach a Data Protection Principle.



Q3. The name and email address of your Chief Pharmacy Information Officer.
I can confirm that PTHB does not have a Chief Pharmacy Information Officer.
