I write further to your request for information which was received on 29 July 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require.

Q5. Across the full contract length, what is the value?

Q6. Can you share the procurement notice?

Q7. How many nurses were provided? If yes, what band and FTE?

Q8. Are their honorary contracts provided? If yes, what band and FTE?

Q9. What other incidentals were included in the tender? Including but not limited to; training, IT, vehicles, grants, travel etc

Q10. What KPIs are included in the agreement and how is success measured?

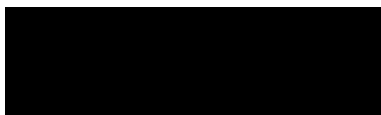
Powys Response:
