Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 9 June 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) partly holds the information that you require.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Q1. Could you please provide the current - and, if different, historic to circa twenty years - schedule of routine replacement of patient monitors in your NHS facilities.

Powys Response:

I can confirm that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not have a routine replacement programme for patient monitors. Individual wards and services purchase their own monitors as and when required.

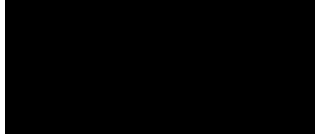
