Q1b – Q1c. Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) is unable to provide the data in the format requested due to the low numbers of individuals involved (5 or less). PTHB believes there is a potential risk of individuals being able to be identified, when considered with other information already available within the public domain, if this was disclosed.
