## Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 11 March 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require.

Powys Response:

Powys Teaching Health Board does not initiate treatment with any of the medicines listed; patients are treated by providers outside of Powys. Powys Teaching Health Board commissions services from a number of Welsh health boards and English provider organisations.

Due to the complex nature of Powys Teaching Health Board's commissioning arrangements, we have not yet received the data to specify which medication all of our patients have been treated with in the last three months. For this reason, Powys Teaching Health Board does not hold the data relating to your request, however, the health board is working closely with providers to ensure that this information can be provided in the future. We therefore recommend that you approach our providers for this information directly:

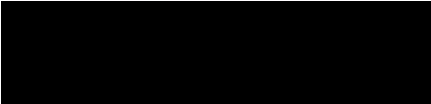
