Section 21 is absolute and therefore does not require a public interest test. Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) has applied this exemption to your request as the information you are seeking is available in the public domain.

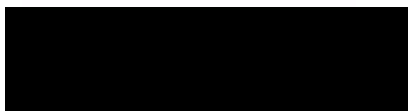
