## Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 8 May 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

### Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I am analysing the usage of intra-vitreous injections or implants by the NHS. I would greatly appreciate if you could answer the following questions:

1. How many of the following intra-vitreous injections/implants has your trust administered in the four-month period from January to April 2025:

- Aflibercept
- Bevacizumab
- Brolucizumab
- Dexamethasone
- Faricimab
- Fluocinolone acetonide
- Ranibizumab - Lucentis
- Ranibizumab - Biosimilar (Ongavia, Ximluci, Byooviz, Rimmyrah)

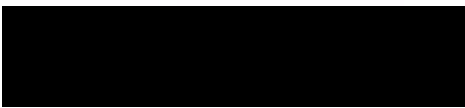
