Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 22 May 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require.

For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Q1. Does Powys Teaching Health Board currently have Dialectical Behavioural Therapists (DBT Therapists) in post? If so, please specify the number of such therapists.

Q2. Please provide the most recent job description and associated pay banding for any Dialectical Behavioural Practitioner or Dialectical Behavioural Therapist post within Powys Teaching Health Board.

Powys Response:

Q1. I can confirm that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) have Dialectical Behavioural Therapists (DBT) in post, however they are not employed specifically into DBT roles. Please see the roles below:

- One clinical associate in applied psychology who also works as a DBT therapist for 1.5 days each week.
- One consultant psychologist who is also a DBT therapist and the team lead for the DBT team.
- Two mental health practitioners who work as DBT therapists for 1.5 days each week.
- Two assistant psychologists (Band 5) who support the DBT service with group facilitation but who are not trained 1:1 DBT therapists.

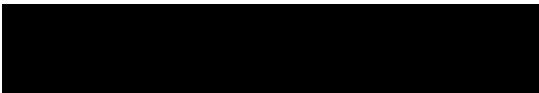
