Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 29 May 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) partly holds the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and my response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I would be grateful if you could please answer the following question. In the last 12 months, how many unique patients have been treated for Insomnia (ICD-10 code G47.0) with the following products:

1. Zopiclone
2. Zolpidem
3. Any other Melatonin product

If you cannot provide the information for each product, please provide the information that you do have available.

Powys Response:

I can confirm that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) are not able to detail the number of unique patients being treated for insomnia with each product listed as we do not have access to this level of data.
