Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 12 November 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require.

For ease of reference your request is set out below, and the Health Board's response follows each question individually.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request and Powys Response (Bold):

Under the FOI act, please can you confirm the below:

Q1. Spend on Insourcing from August 2025-end of October 2025, broken down by each specialty and subspecialty, and the insourcing company that was used, e.g. cardiology £1000- echo cardiogram £1000- company x £1000. - **I can confirm that Medinet was used for insourcing. Total spend for this period was £34,339. Please note this does not include October 2025 invoices as these costs are not currently available. Please see the breakdown below:**

Endoscopy Bowel Screening	£6,154
Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT)	£6,000

Q2. The budget for each specialty for insourcing. - **I can confirm that there is no designated budget.**

Q3. Confirm the contract start and end date for each specialty. - **Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) have only used one insourcing company, and the contract commenced April 2025 and ends March 2026.**
