## Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 24 November 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and the Health Board's response follows.

### Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I am submitting a formal request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 for the following information regarding any contracts or agreements between Powys Teaching Health Board and the company Palantir Technologies:

1. Copies of all contracts between Powys Teaching Health Board and Palantir Technologies, including any contracts for data services, software solutions, or consultancy, for the period from start of the contract to the current date and data available .
2. Details of the financial terms of these contracts, including the total value of the contracts, any milestone payments, or additional costs incurred during the contract period.
3. A breakdown of the services or products provided under these contracts (e.g., data analytics, data integration, AI tools, software platforms).
4. Documents related to the procurement process, including any tender documents, bids, and evaluation summaries related to Palantir's involvement with [NHS body name].
5. Any amendments, extensions, or variations to the contracts with Palantir, including the reasons for such changes.

I would appreciate it if the information could be provided in a digital format (e.g., PDF, Excel). If the information is available through a public portal or online system, please direct me to the appropriate resources.

Q1 – Q5. I can confirm that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not have any contracts with Palantir Technologies. Therefore, this is a nil response.
