Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 27 October 2025, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require.

For ease of reference your request is set out below and the Health Board's response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I am submitting this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding private oncology services and prescribing within the NHS Trust.

Additionally, if certain data points are not recorded in the exact format requested, I would welcome any alternative figures or insights. When referring to a private patient, this is a patient treated within NHS facilities but not funded by the NHS.

Powys Response:

Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not carry out any private prescribing for cancer treatments.

PTHB does not have District General Hospital (DGH) services or provide cancer services. PTHB does not initiate treatment with any of the medicines listed; patients may be treated by providers outside of Powys. The Health Board commissions these services from a number of Welsh Health Boards and English provider organisations.

Due to the complex nature of these commissioning arrangements, not all of our providers indicate the indication for use for each episode of care where these drugs are used. For this reason, PTHB does not hold the data relating to your request. However, the Health Board is working closely with providers to ensure that this information can be provided in the future.

We therefore recommend that you approach our provider organisations directly for this information. Please note that all providers may not necessarily offer services that fall within the definition in your request.

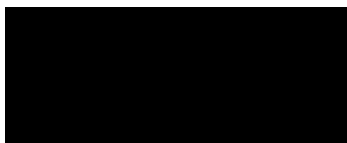
Re-use of Public Sector Information
