Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 25 February 2026, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require, but have applied an exemption to elements of this request.

For ease of reference your request is set out below and the Health Board's response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please provide the following information relating to your organisation's financial position and expenditure for each of the last five completed financial years (2020/21 to 2024/25).

Q1. Overall Financial Position

For each financial year, please confirm:

- Total annual revenue expenditure.
- Total annual capital expenditure.
- Whether the organisation recorded a surplus, deficit, or broke even (including the amount).

Q2. Agency and External Support Costs

For each financial year, please provide:

- Total expenditure on agency staff (including medical, nursing, and other staff categories).
- Total expenditure on management consultancy services.
- Total expenditure on external legal services.

Q3. Senior Management Costs

For each financial year:

- Total remuneration paid to Executive and Board-level Directors (including salary, pension contributions, bonuses, and taxable benefits).
- The number of Executive Directors employed.

Q4. Procurement and Contracting

For the most recently completed financial year only:

- The total value of contracts awarded without competitive tender.
- The number of such contracts.
- A copy of the current procurement policy (or a link if publicly available).

Q5. Welsh Government Funding

Please confirm:

- Total funding received directly from Welsh Government in each financial year.
- Any additional in-year financial support, brokerage, or exceptional funding received.

Format Requested: Please provide the information electronically in spreadsheet format (Excel or CSV).

Powys Response:

Q1 - Q2 & Q4 - Q5. Please see FOI.087.26 Attachment 1 for Powys Teaching Health Board's (PTHB) response to your request.

Q3. Under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act, an organisation does not have to respond to a request if the information being sought is accessible to the applicant by another means. Section 21 is absolute and therefore does not require a public interest test. PTHB has applied this exemption to your request as the information you are seeking is available in the public domain.

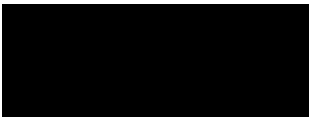
Re-use of Public Sector Information
