Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information, which was received on 23 January 2026, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and the Health Board's response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act to request the following information: I'm looking for information relating to corporate subscriptions to/ for LinkedIn, benefits and assessments of value-for-money.

- a) If your organisation has paid an annual or recurring subscription to/for LinkedIn then how much was spent each year in FY2020-21, FY2021-22, FY2022-23, FY2023-24, FY2024-25?
- b) If your organisation has paid an annual or recurring subscription to/for LinkedIn then what benefits/services were offered by it for each year in FY2020-21, FY2021-22, FY2022-23, FY2023-24, FY2024-25?
- c) If your organisation has paid an annual or recurring subscription to/for LinkedIn then what assessment of value-for-money was made for each year of FY2020-21, FY2021-22, FY2022-23, FY2023-24, FY2024-25? Please provide the assessments for each year.

For absolute certainty, please do not aggregate the figures/data for the five financial years, present them separately so they may be compared.
