Q5. How many type 2 diabetes patients (all adults & paediatrics) specifically on insulin do you care for in your hospitals?

Please note: Due to the rural and sparsely populated nature of Powys, we do not have district general hospital services within the county. Our residents access their acute and specialist services in District General Hospitals (DGH) provided by neighbouring health boards in Wales and neighbouring NHS Trusts in England.

Q1. Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) provides a midwife-led maternity service offering home births and births in a midwife-led maternity unit. PTHB does not treat for gestational diabetes; patients are treated by providers outside of Powys. PTHB commissions services from several Welsh health boards and English provider organisations.

The table below lists the main health boards and NHS Trust from which we commission health services for Powys residents. Please note that all providers may not necessarily offer services that fall within the definition in your request.

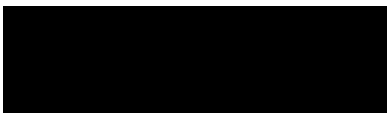
Re-use of Public Sector Information
