I write further to your request for information which was received on 4 June 2026, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and the Health Board's response follows each question individually.

### Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request and Powys Response (Bold):

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information from Powys Teaching Health Board. I am requesting this information as it is not routinely published in your health board papers. Please could you provide me with:

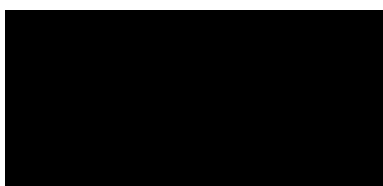
