Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 25 June 2026, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and the Health Board's response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am writing to request contact information for all General Practitioner (GP) practices currently operating within your health board's area. Specifically, I request that the data be provided in an electronic format (CSV or Excel) containing the following fields for each practice:

- Official NHS Practice Code
- GP Practice / Surgery Name
- Main Administrative or Public Contact Email Address (e.g. reception, enquiries, or practice manager)

For the avoidance of doubt, I am requesting publicly held administrative contact addresses rather than personal email addresses of individual clinicians.

If email addresses are only available for a subset of practices, please provide what is held rather than treating the request as undeliverable in full.

If this information is already available in a centralised dataset, I would be grateful if you could direct me to the relevant URL. I look forward to your response within the statutory 20 working days.

Powys Response:

Under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act, an organisation does not have to respond to a request if the information being sought is reasonably accessible to the applicant by another means. 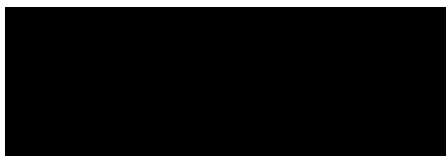
Re-use of Public Sector Information
