Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information which was received on 05 March 2026, to confirm, in accordance with S.1(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, that Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold the information that you require. For ease of reference your request is set out below and the Health Board's response follows.

Your Freedom of Information (FOI) Request:

Q1. Under the Freedom of Information Act, could you please confirm how many people within your Health Board are currently be prescribed continuous glucose monitoring (CGM) such as Freestyle Libra or Dexcom ONE, broken down by Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes?

Powys Response:

Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB) does not hold patient-level information on the number of individuals currently prescribed continuous glucose monitoring (CGM) devices such as Freestyle Libre or Dexcom ONE, and we are therefore unable to provide a breakdown by diabetes type (Type 1 or Type 2).

However, prescribing volume data for these devices in primary care is publicly available via the NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership (NWSSP) General Practice Prescribing Data Extract, which provides prescribing activity for medicines and appliances issued by GP practices, including those within Powys Teaching Health Board.

This resource provides prescribing volumes (for example number of items prescribed) but does not contain patient-level data or diagnostic breakdowns.


